Welcome to women's discipleship!

Discipleship is Jesus' idea and command. By His authority, we take a deliberate approach to discipleship at FFC. By God's grace, our approach recognizes and takes the roles God has given men and women into account, and provides an intentional avenue to encourage living them out biblically.



Is there a biblical pattern for women's discipleship?

Yes! The church is to equip older women to disciple younger women to think and live according to biblical womanhood (Titus 2:3-5). We live in a world that is confused and conflicted regarding womanhood. We can no longer take a back seat on this issue. Instead, we've got to go to Scripture, and then intentionally and joyfully pass on the legacy of Biblical womanhood—for God's glory.

Older women as coaches

In Titus 2, older women are given the command to teach younger women—this is something that's needful in the church!

Many women already enjoy a network of relationships, and that's great. In FFC women's discipleship, younger women and older women become involved in a one-year commitment to a coaching relationship. Younger women are not necessarily younger in age, but desire to consider a biblical apologetic for women in their life context, and want to become more Christ-like in other areas, as well.

What can I expect?

After you've submitted an application, when a coach who fits your needs becomes available, there'll be a start-up meeting. At that meeting, goals will be discussed and resources will be provided.

You can expect a warm, purposeful relationship that is specific to your needs, and grows you as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Of course, every relationship takes on its own definition as you go along, but you can anticipate built-in accountability.

We'll expect you to be faithful to your commitment, such as by being on time for meetings with your coach. Other expectations will be set for you by your coach.

What do I do next?

In January of 2011, you can join a three-month Sunday Morning Bible Class for discipleship teams and women who are interested in being part of a discipleship team.
