

## SALVATION SESSION FOUR

### GLORIFICATION (Romans 8:19-39)

#### I. INTRODUCTION

A Believer's present perspective in sanctification is having **Hope** in the future prospective of being glorified for eternity. It is a consummation of salvation either by one's physical death or the promised return of Jesus Christ. This will be the perfection of the pursuit of holiness as a Believer's sin nature is removed by God, being then completely **Conformed** to the likeness of Jesus Christ in His resurrected and glorified body and being.

#### II. GLORIFICATION- *"from glory to glory"* 2 Corinthians 3:18

##### A. Procured by Jesus Christ

1. Jesus' death **Fulfilled** the will of God. Isaiah 53, Hebrews 10:5-10

*"By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."* Hebrews 10:10

2. Jesus' death **Secured** our glorification. Hebrews 10:11-18, Romans 8:37,38

*"For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified."*  
Hebrews 10:14

3. Jesus' glorification results in our **Victorious** glorification. 1 Corinthians 15:50-57

*"Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him as He is."*  
1 John 3:2

*"...who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself."* Philippians 3:21

##### B. Predestined by God

1. The fulfillment of God's **Promise** for our future can be understood in the present.

*"...that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints."* Ephesians 1:18

2. The promise of glorification is **Planned** and performed by God. Romans 8:29

*“Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.”* Romans 8:30

3. The riches of God’s glory is **Prepared** for those whom God shows mercy.

*“and that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy which He had prepared beforehand for glory.”* Romans 9:30

4. The power and presence of God will **Deliver** us from the power and presence of sin.

*“...He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.”* Romans 8:11

### C. Present Hope for Believers-Romans 8:18-39

All present sufferings can be **Endured** because of the future glory attained- vs. 18

The promise of deliverance produces **Patience** and perseverance- vs. 19-22

The Holy Spirit **Delivers** us from all hopelessness- vs.23

Our hope is an **Exercise** in faith-vs.24-25

The Holy Spirit **Ministers** to us and acts for us in our weakness- vs. 26, 27

God has **Purposed** everything in our lives to prepare us and accomplish His will- vs. 28

God’s sovereignty is **Displayed** in our conforming to the righteousness of Christ- vs. 29

The Divine plan of sanctification is **Fulfilled** in our glorification-vs. 30

The power of God is our **Deliverance** and confidence-vs. 31,32

Christians are eternally **Secure** in their spiritual state of justification- vs. 33-36

A Christian’s assurance of **Victory** is certain in Jesus Christ-vs. 37

We have complete confidence that nothing can **Separate** us from being glorified- vs.38,39
